

THE RICH WINE-GROWING HERITAGE OF THE LOIR VALLEY REVEALED



The Château de Fontenay-sur-Vègre, a medieval gem dating back to the 13th century, will transport you through 800 years of history. It served as the setting for *The Man in the Iron Mask* with Leonardo DiCaprio and enchants visitors with its hexagonal tower, its dovecote with 600 pigeon-holes, its vaulted cellar - the largest in La Sarthe - and the River Vègre, which flows close by. The site can sleep 51 people (15 in the château and 36 in the gîte), and offers sports facilities and bespoke services, making it the ideal venue for family gatherings.

LE MANS ON THE BIG SCREEN

THE CITÉ PLANTAGENÊT, A REAL-LIFE MOVIE BACKDROP!

Did you know that Le Mans is one of the best-preserved historical cities in France?

It boasts a rich history and unique architectural heritage and is much sought-after by film-makers from around the world. The Cité Plantagenêt, the historical heart of Le Mans, astounds visitors with the architectural unity found in an area of almost 20 hectares where every street and every facade tell a story. With its well-preserved buildings, mainly built over the 15th and 16th centuries, it offers film crews a real journey back in time. Actor Pierre Arditi sums it up perfectly: "When you make a film in Le Mans, you get the distinct feeling that the entire community falls into synch with the crews who come to capture a story in their hometown."


And these are not just empty words: some of the world's biggest film-makers endorse this view, selecting Le Mans as the backdrop for their films. Major films such as *Cyrano de Bergerac* starring Gérard Depardieu and Philippe de Broca's *On Guard* have been made here. Even Hollywood has succumbed to the city's charm! In 1999, *The Man in the Iron Mask* starring Leonardo di Caprio, and in 2019, *Ford vs. Ferrari* starring Matt Damon and Christian Bale, were filmed in the old town.



Le Mans is a vibrant movie backdrop, fascinating both film-makers and their viewers, a city where the pristine beauty of the past meets the allure of the silver screen. It's hardly surprising that so many cameras are drawn to this location!

AN OUTSTANDING GALLO-ROMAN WALL

Built between the third and fourth centuries, this wall surrounded the ancient city of Vindinum, capital of the Aulerci Cenomani Gallic tribe. Along with the walls of Rome and Constantinople (Istanbul), it is one of the best preserved in the ancient Roman Empire. There are 500 metres of the polychrome walls still standing. They feature geometric patterns and are interspersed with 11 towers. This architectural masterpiece reflected the city's power and wealth. Le Mans city council has now applied for UNESCO World Heritage listing for the wall.

STREET ART TAKES OVER LE MANS

URBAN ART COLOURS THE CITY'S STREETS

FESTIVAL PLEIN CHAMP, 4-6 JULY

Launched in 2019, the Plein Champ festival brings together an array of international street artists over the first weekend of July. These artists spend three days creating designs live before the public, on mobile structures such as cubes and sections of wall. To add to the festival vibe, there are DJ sets, local food trucks, and more. This free event is a great opportunity for the public to come along and meet the artists. Youngsters can even try and create their own street art at one of the workshops held during the event.

The city of Le Mans and Bulle, a bookshop specialising in graphic novels, were behind the creation of this mural in the city centre. The work is the result of a joint project involving Belgian comic strip artist François Schuiten and street artist Wen2, and evokes the falotiers, the "lamplighters" who lit up our towns in the 19th and 20th centuries.

This town in the Alpes Mancelles was awarded the "Town of Arts and Crafts" label in 2023. It is home to a dozen or so artists and craftspeople working in different disciplines and always keen to share their art, including jewellers, stained glass artists, leather workers, and more.

ONE OF THE LAST WEAPONSMITHS IN FRANCE: PASCAL TURPIN

Pascal Turpin brings unique creations to life! His daggers, swords and knives tell the story of La Sarthe. For example, the Montmirail, made from beams from the castle of the same name, or his folding knives in the shape of some of the iconic cars to have raced in the Le Mans 24 Hours. His latest jewel is the Fresnois, celebrating the village's weaving past

MALICORNE-SUR-SARTHE, THE EARTHENWARE VILLAGE

Malicorne-sur-Sarthe has been a major hub for French earthenware production for centuries. In 1924, Émile Tessier invented the openwork technique which has since become a local speciality. Today, two earthenware workshops continue the tradition, alongside a museum dedicated to the craft. Awarded the "Town of Arts and Crafts" label, Malicorne is home to several talented craftspeople whose works are the pride of the Arts and Crafts store found on the first floor of the former "mill of colours". With so much charm and creativity on display, this is a destination you won't want to miss!





La Vélobuissonnière also attracts cyclists with its landscapes, including the Alpes Mancelles with their age-old scree slopes and rugged, hilly scenery, awarded the UNESCO Global Geopark label this year. As it is close to the French capital (55 minutes by high-speed train from Paris to Le Mans), this is a great idea for a weekend or a week's jaunt for city dwellers.

A LOW-CARBON STAY

Sarthe Tourism has put together a three-day "low-carbon" cycling weekend that starts from Montparnasse station in Paris (a short 54-minute train journey from Le Mans). When you arrive, hire a bike at Brico Cycles in Le Mans (a 10-minute walk from the station), then follow our plan!















DAY 1

START: LE MANS FINISH: LA FLÈCHE 66 KM (5 HOURS' CYCLING)

This section of La Vélobuissonnière runs along the River Sarthe, then dips into an area of woodland and bocage. It's an easy route for beginners.

WHAT TO SEE? The island of MoulinSart (watermill and contemporary art centre), the craft and earthenware workshops in Malicorne-sur-Sarthe, and the military academy in La Flèche.

WHAT TO DO? Bathe in La Gèmerie lake in Arnage, sample local produce at the La Ménagerie farm in Malicorne-sur-Sarthe, and go surfing on an efoil board.

WHERE TO EAT? La Maison Nipa in Fillé-sur-Sarthe or Le Moulin des Quatre Saisons in La Flèche.

WHERE TO SLEEP? The

Camp'étoiles structures at the Route d'Or campsite, are ideal for cycle tourers. They can accommodate up to four people. Charging points are also available

DAY 2

START: LA FLÈCHE FINISH: MONTVAL-SUR-LOIR 52 KM (3-4 HOURS' CYCLING)

Follow the La Flèche-Le Lude greenway, then continue on the Loir Valley by Bike trail along the banks of the Loir, with its rich heritage of châteaux, manor houses and fortified tufa stone mills.

WHAT TO SEE? The Château du Lude, the "Petite Cité de Caractère" of Luché-Pringé, the fortified Mervé mill.

WHAT TO DO? Discover the leather goods crafted at the Maroquinerie du Loir in Vaas, taste the cheeses from the Ferme du Frêne in Le Lude, and visit Le Temps d'un Champs educational farm in Montval-sur-Loir.

WHERE TO EAT? The guinguette in Thorée-les-Pins or Le Grand Hôtel in Montval-sur-Loir.

WHERE TO SLEEP? Le Grand Hôtel is a 3-star Logis establishment and has been awarded the "Accueil Vélo" (bike-friendly) label. The hotel has locked bicycle storage.



START: MONTVAL-SUR-LOIR FINISH: LE MANS (TRAIN)

Take the train from Montval-sur-Loir to Le Mans and then enjoy a day wandering around La Sarthe's enchanting capital.

WHAT TO SEE? The Cité Plantagenêt (Le Mans medieval district), L'Épau Royal Abbey, and Le Mans' Gallo-Roman wall.

WHAT TO DO? Discover the many works of street art, taste the offerings from the Le Sonneur distillery, and take a trip along the River Sarthe on a traditional boat.

WHERE TO EAT? L'Épi'Curieux restaurant and La Guinguette des Tanneries in Le Mans.

WHERE TO SLEEP? In the ecolodges at the Domaine de l'Épau, in Yvré-L'évêque. These semi-sunken structures are very low on energy consumption. There's a swimming pool and a restaurant so you can still treat yourself during your eco-friendly stay!




